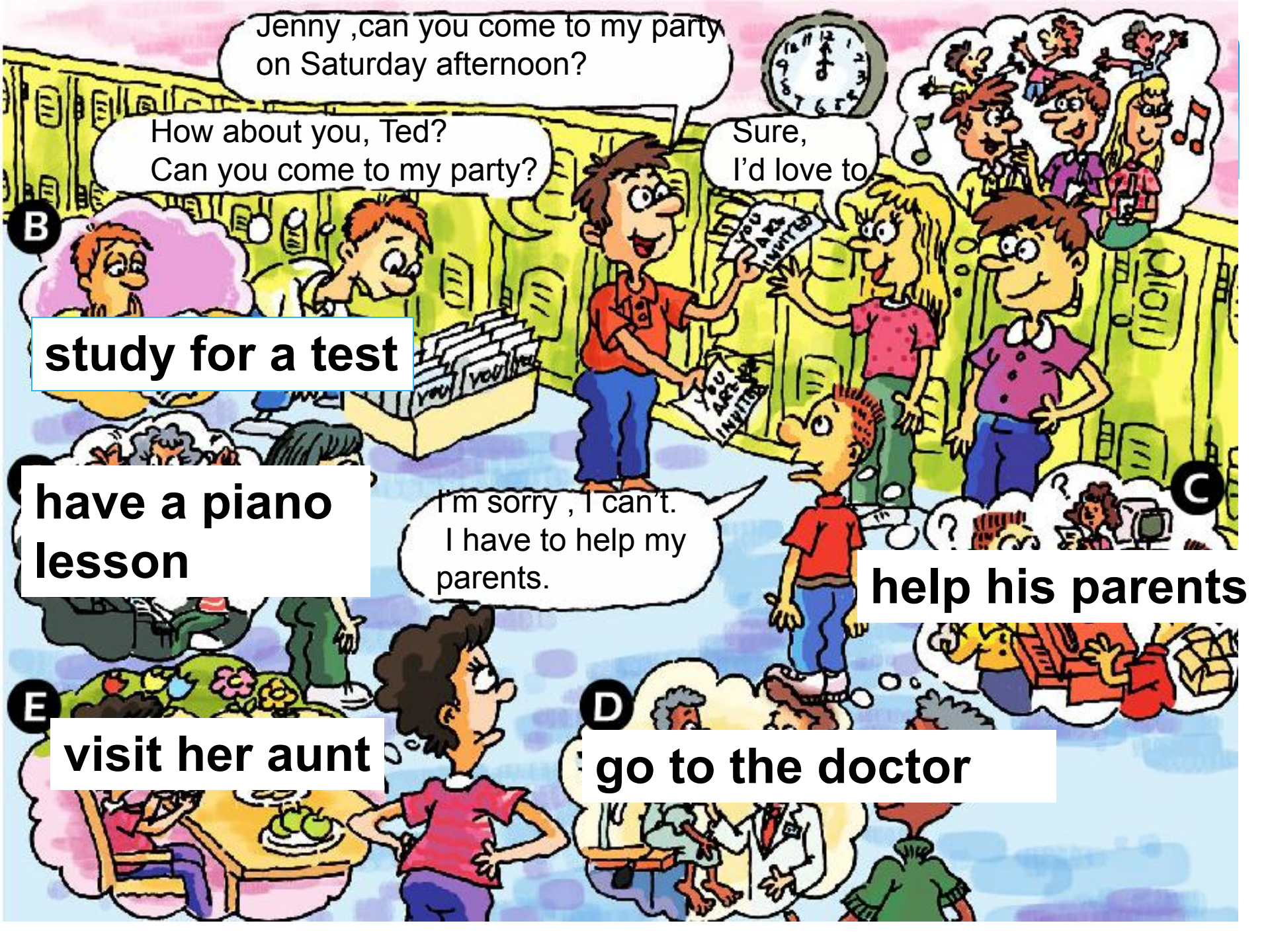

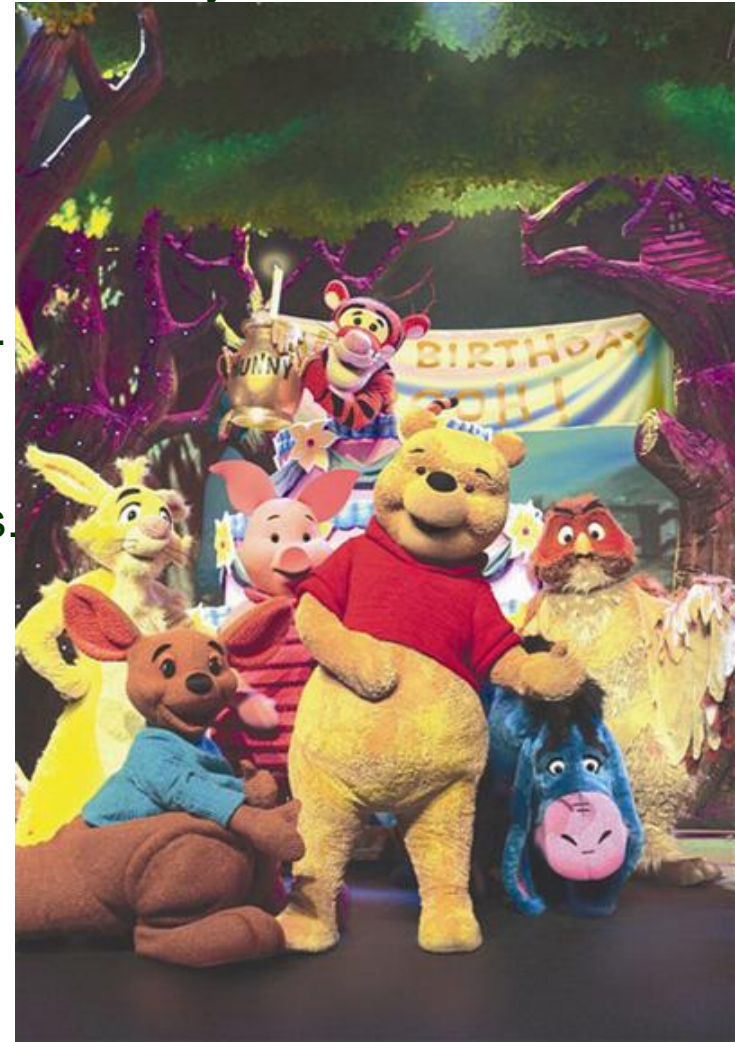

Yes, he can.



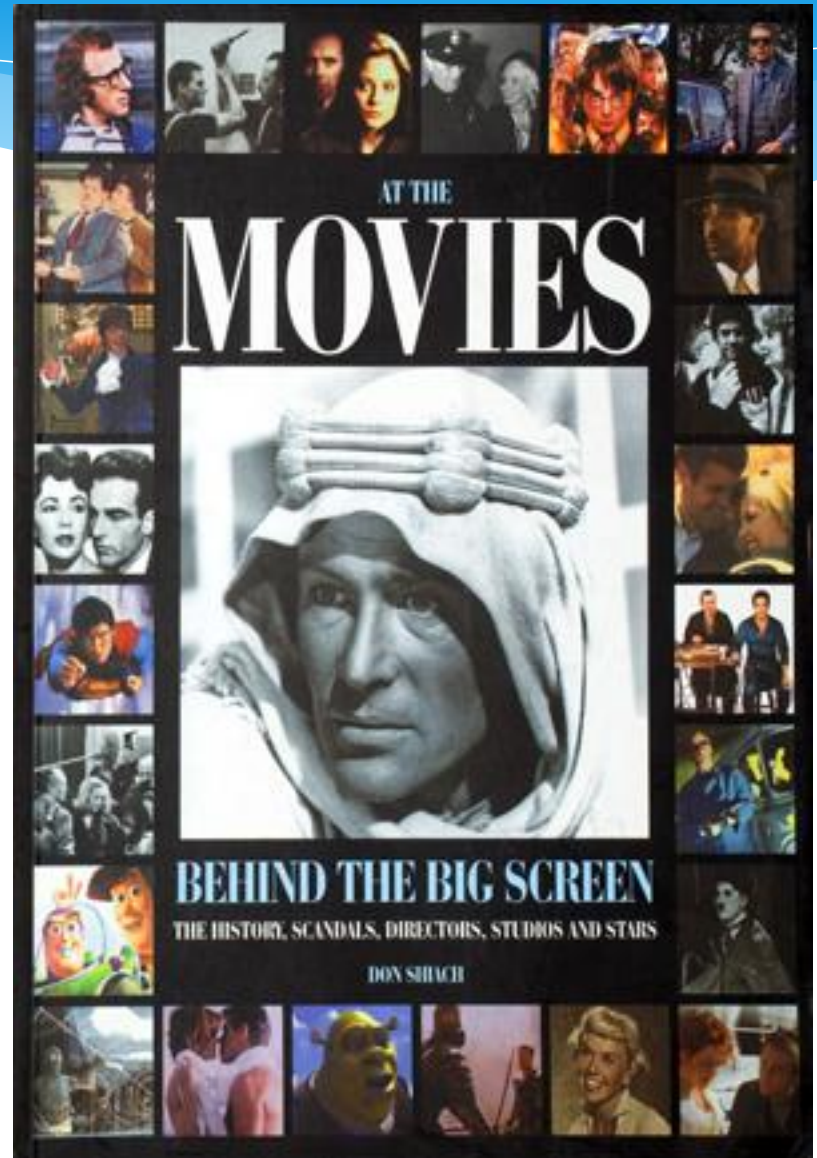
Pair work:

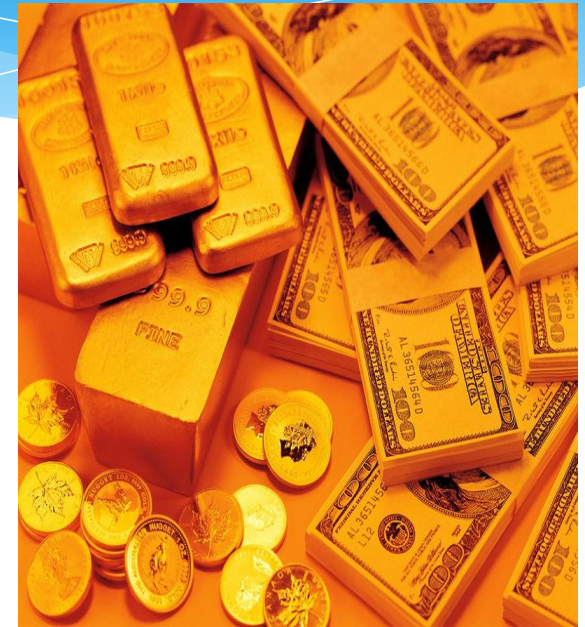
